Your proxy will also be entitled to vote at his/her discretion on any resolution properly put to the AGM other than those referred to in the Notice. If you wish to vote part of your shares for and part of your shares against the relevant resolution in the event that a poll is called, please insert the number of shares of the Company in the relevant box.
- The form of proxy must be signed by the appointor or his attorney duly authorised in writing or, if such appointor is a corporation, must be either under its common seal or under the hand of an officer, attorney or other person authorised to sign the same.
- In the case of joint shareholders, the signature of any one shareholder will be sufficient but the names of all the joint shareholders should be stated.
- Where there are joint holders of any share of the Company, any one of such joint holders may vote at the AGM, either in person or by proxy, in respect of such share as if he/she were solely entitled thereto, but if more than one of such joint holders is present at the AGM, the vote of the senior holder who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, will be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of the other joint holders, and for this purpose, seniority shall be determined by the order in which the names stand in the register of members in respect of the joint holding.
- To be valid, this form of proxy must be completed, signed and deposited at the Company’s Hong Kong branch share registrar, Tricor Investor Services Limited (the “**Hong Kong Share Registrar**”) at 17/F, Far East Finance Centre, 16 Harcourt Road, Hong Kong together with a power of attorney or other authority, if any, under which it is signed (or a certified copy thereof), not later than 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the AGM or the adjournment thereof. Completion and return of the form of proxy shall not preclude Members from subsequently attending and voting in person at the AGM or the adjournment thereof should you so wish, and in such event, the form of proxy shall be deemed to be revoked.
- Any alteration made to this form of proxy must be initialed by the person who signs it.
- The Company reserves its right to treat any form of proxy which has been incorrectly completed in some manner as valid if such incorrectness is considered by the Company, at its absolute discretion, not material.
- A Member or his/her/its proxy should produce proof of identity when attending the AGM. If a corporate Member appoints its representative to attend the AGM, such representative should produce proof of identity and a copy of the resolution of the board of directors or other governing body of that Member appointing such representative to attend the AGM.

- You have the right to request access to and/or correction of your Personal Data in accordance with the provisions of the PDPO.
